Training League and the relationship between the state and NRDP is unique. Most states do not work with the referee program. US Soccer is watching what we are working on with the TL to use as a model for other states. NRDP is submitting a grant proposal to US Soccer to assist with the TL. Currently have 940 active/registered referees, most in the last seven years. Goal is to reach 1200 in the next three years.
